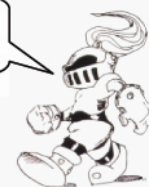

The STMC Alumni Association - The Next 50 Years

Last spring, Jen Shelnutt joined the STMC Community as the new Director of the Office of Development and Community Relations. Some of you may have already met Jen. She is a tireless worker with a wealth of experience in fundraising and community building. Jen recognized early on that she needed help with respect to community building especially with the alumni. In light of this, the leadership of STMC has adjusted my teaching load and asked me to take on the newly created position of **Alumni Relations Officer**.

There is no doubt that STMC would not be where it is today if it were not for the support of its alumni. Over the years our Knights of Old have given back by participating in various fundraisers like the GKO, the Alumni Basketball Tourney, the Phonathon and capital campaigns like the Pursuit of Excellence Campaign in the 80's and the first Phase of the current campaign. It is a lofty goal but one that is achievable.

However, I also know that a lot of what those talented and gifted Knights could offer our community goes untapped, not due to lack of willingness to give back but rather due to the fact that they have not been approached in an effective way. My job is to rectify this situation by creating more opportunities to connect through improved communication and offering a variety of fun-filled, community building events. In order to ensure that we are meeting the needs of the community I will also be forming an Alumni Advisory Board which will meet periodically throughout the year.

One of the first things I will be doing is forming an **Alumni Advisory Board** which will meet periodically throughout the year to ensure that we are meeting the needs of the community. Both the junior and varsity coaches were very pleased with the effort they saw at the spring camp and the prospects for the coming season. From a coaching perspective we are truly blessed with a variety of alumni and friends of the STMC Football community volunteering to help. We thank them all and could not field a team without them! Coaching the Varsity with me is **Brian Higgins ('68)**, Dave Mattiazzo (World's fastest Campus Minister), Joe Adams (teacher) and **Jared Power ('05)**. Dave Ruzucki (teacher) will be the Head JV coach.
